Rules of Play



General

Disc Golf is played similar to ball golf except using a flying disc. One point is counted each time the disc is thrown and when a penalty is incurred. The winner is the golfer with the lowest score.



Tee Throws

Tee throws must be completed within or behind the designated tee area. Do not throw until the players in front of you are out of range.



Lie

A lie is the spot where the previous throw has landed and can be marked with a mini disc or by turning over the thrown disc.



Throwing Order

After teeing off, the player whose disc is farthest from the hole always throws first. The player with the lowest score from the previous hole is the first to tee off on the next hole.



Fairway Throws

Stay behind the lie for your next fairway throw.



Completion of Hole

Golfer completes the hole when a disc lands inside the basket or chains.

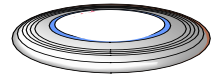


Out-of-Bounds

These areas include roads, water, walkways, and more than two meters above the ground. Discs are played from the point where the disc went out-of-bounds. One penalty point is given.

Disc Golf Course Location and Parking

Eagle Ridge Park is the area that lies between the Civic Center Park and Route 25 in Oswego. The Waubonsie Trail winds through this park, connecting with the Fox River Trail at Violet Patch Park. To get to the disc golf course, park at the Civic Center, 5 Ashlawn Ave, Montgomery, or park at Violet Patch Park on Route 25 and walk the Waubonsie Trail to the disc golf course.
