Oswegoland Park District Summary of Park Rules

1. **Dogs** must be kept on a leash; owners must clean up after them.
2. **Fireworks, guns and weapons** are not allowed on Park District property.
3. Amusements and equipment including but not limited to **generators, moonjumps, dunk tanks, petting zoo's, and pony rides** require written permission from the Director of the Park District.
4. All **vehicles** should be driven on road and parking areas; no parking on the grass.
5. Those wishing to **sell** anything on park property must obtain written permission from the Board of Commissioners of the Oswegoland Park District.
6. Any **group gathering** on Park District property that might stop traffic or interfere with the business of the Park District must give written notice to the Director of the Park District. The date, time and purpose of the gathering must be included.
7. **Fires** are allowed only in grills and fire pits, must be attended at all times, and extinguished before leaving.
8. Persons using or under the influence of **drugs** are not allowed on Park District property. Although consuming **alcoholic beverages** is permissible, persons under the influence of alcohol are not allowed to remain in the parks.
9. **Litter** must be put in trash cans. Groups generating more trash than containers can hold are responsible for removing the excess trash.
10. Anyone intending to display **advertisements on Park District property** must request **permission in writing from the Director of the Park District**. Advertisements may not impair traffic or Park District business.
11. **Animals, birds and their homes** must be left alone.
12. **Trees, shrubs and flowers** must be left alone. Fences, signs, structures and other Park District property are provided for use, not abuse, and should not be damaged in any way.
13. No one shall threaten the safety or well-being of another person. **Illinois disorderly conduct laws** are enforced in the parks.
14. The **parks are open from dawn to dusk** unless posted otherwise or special arrangements are made.
15. Posted **speed limits** must be observed.
16. There is a **fine and penalty of \$25-\$200 for the violation of each ordinance**.
