

### CONTACT INFORMATION



- Motorized vehicles are prohibited from trails and paths.
- Dogs must be kept on a leash; owners must clean up after their pet.
- · Please use the trash and recycle bins don't litter.



Following these basic courtesy rules will also provide an enjoyable time for all trail users.



- · Walk, run, skate and bike on the right.
- Please do not walk more than two abreast.
- Walk, run, skate or ride single file when path is in heavy use.
- · Pass on the left.
- · Ring a bell or use a verbal warning when passing.
- Bicyclists should always ride under control and watch their speed.
- Pedestrians have the right-of-way. Bikers and skaters must yield to walkers.
- · Obey all posted signs.
- · Dog owners please clean up after your pets.

- Trails are designed with your safety in mind and are marked with miniature traffic signs. It is important to heed these signs, just as you would on any roadway.
   Parents, this is a great opportunity to teach your children the rules of the road.
- Bikers and skaters should wear helmets and other protective gear.
- Be aware of the other users on the path and that individuals may be passing you.
- Be courteous of other users.
- During the winter, the Park District keeps the paved paths plowed, but users should be aware that there may be icy conditions due to the weather and the high volume of foot/bike traffic that packs down the snow before plows can remove it.
