

## Kid's Connection – Remote Learning FAQs



### **Q. How will my child be supported during remote learning?**

**A.** SD308 is providing technology support during the remote learning time. SD308 staff will assist children to keep them focused and stay on task.

### **Q. My child does not attend District 308 schools; can they still attend your remote program?**

**A.** At this time, we are unable to accommodate participants from other districts.

### **Q. Where will the program be held?**

**A.** The program will be held at multiple sites to accommodate the number of children. We will follow CDC guidelines and limit small group sizes with a ratio of 1:10. Each site will have a maximum of 40 children. The program will be held at The Wheatland's, Churchill, Southbury, and Prairie Point Elementary. Parents can choose the location that meets their needs. If enrollment warrants, we will open additional elementary schools.

### **Q. Will siblings be kept together?**

**A.** Yes, siblings can attend the same school location. Participants will be divided by grade at the site. Siblings may be together, but only if they happen to fall within the grade range for the remote learning time with SD308 staff.

### **Q. Can my child do partial days or only attend a few days a week?**

**A.** The program will run Monday-Friday from 7:00am-6:15pm. You may choose to attend 2, 3, or 5 days per week. You can choose any combination of days, but they must remain consistent week to week.

### **Q. How will you handle Teacher Institute Days or days when there is no remote learning?**

**A.** On days when there is no remote learning, the Park District will offer full day recreational programming. See our program brochure for further information. The cost for these days is \$39 per day. Registration will be online.

### **Q. How will you accommodate children with special needs?**

**A.** The Park District works with FVSRA on inclusion support for children with special needs in recreation programs before and after school, however the Park District is not qualified to fulfill IEP requirements. Please communicate any specific accommodations needed at the time of enrollment. We encourage you to contact SD308 prior to enrolling if your child needs support during the remote learning time.

### **Q. Will there be scholarships available?**

**A.** Financial assistance may be available for those that meet specific conditions. Please contact us for an application.

### **Q. Why is this program being held, but my child can't go to school?**

**A.** In an effort to support the community we have entered into a partnership with SD308 to provide safe and supervised childcare. Each site has a capacity of 50 people including staff to help us adhere to IDPH social distancing guidelines.

### **Q. Will meals be provided at Kid's Connection?**

**A.** Meal service including breakfast, lunch, and snack for the children will be provided through Aramark Food Service at no additional cost to the parents. Parents may send a lunch from home in place of the food service if they choose.

### **Q. Who should I contact for additional questions?**
