

As We Grow Preschool - FAQs



Q. Will students and teachers be required to wear masks in the classroom and public areas at all times?

A. Yes, participants and staff will wear a mask in the classroom and all common areas. When outside, we will have a designated area for children who would like a break from wearing their face covering. Social distancing will be required and monitored closely in this area.

Q. How many children will be in each classroom?

A. Each classroom will have no more than 12 students.

Q. What is the student to teacher ratio?

A. The student to teacher ratio is 6:1. The ratio will never go above this.

Q. How will social distancing be achieved in the classroom?

A. Children will be seated 6 feet apart at tables. All learning and playing activities will be designed with social distancing in mind. We will encourage and remind students to spread apart when necessary. Kids get to know one another and develop friendships while learning and practicing important developmental skills.

Q. Will participants still be able to register for Lunch Box Club and other enrichment programs?

A. Yes, Lunch Box Club and various enrichment programs are scheduled to begin the third week of school.

Q. Will parents be allowed to walk their child into the building?

A. All parents are asked to use the drop-off service to minimize the number of people entering the building.

Drop-off: Please get your child out of their car seat and remain at your car until a teacher comes to you. The teacher will have you sign your child in and they will escort your child into the building.

Pick-up: We will come out of the school as a class and wait in a line. You will be given a sign your child's name on it to display in your front passenger window. Please remain at your car. We will walk your child to you. If someone other than the usual pick-up person is coming, we ask that you notify us beforehand. We will check their ID against our authorized pick-up in ePact.

Q. Will temperatures be taken when participants are being dropped off?

A. No, parents will self-certify prior to bringing the child to class.

Q. Will you eliminate special events and outside visitors?

A. While we absolutely love welcoming families into our preschool for special events, we are being cautious and will only allow students and staff inside preschool classrooms at this time. We will reassess this decision throughout the year.

Q. What will a typical day look like?

A. A typical day in preschool this year will look very similar to before. The main differences will be increased disinfecting and sanitizing of toys and hands, and that all will be wearing face coverings. We will still play together and read stories. We will still dance and sing. Your child will still create amazing little projects and treasures throughout the day. Our teachers will be encouraged to spend more time outside while the weather is nice.
