Dear As We Grow Preschool Parents,

A warm welcome back to our returning families and to our many new families! We are so excited to have each of you in our preschool program this fall. As always, we want to make this a year of learning, new friendships, and independence for your preschooler. Together, we can make a great experience for your child.

**Preschool classes begin Tuesday and Wednesday, September 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup>:**

- The morning preschool will be 9:15am-11:45am (2-day and 3-day).
- The 4-day morning will be 9:15am-11:30am.
- Our afternoon preschool will be 12:30pm-3:00pm (2-day and 3 day).
- The 4-day afternoon will be 12:15pm-2:30pm.

Parents will attend the first day of school with their child. This day will last about 45 minutes. Look for a postcard at the end of August from your child's teacher with your scheduled time. You and your child will see the classroom, meet the teacher, and get to know other children who will be in class with your child. Additional information regarding your child's classroom will also be provided on this day.

We have a **Parent Information Night** for each location:

- Civic Center: Wednesday, August 25 starting at 6:00pm at Civic Center, 5 Ashlawn Ave.
- South Point: Thursday, August 26 starting at 6:00pm at South Point, 810 Preston Lane. Enter Door 7.

**Your preschool tuition payment is due the first of every month starting on September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021.** We encourage you to set up AUTOCHARGE/EFT for your convenience, please contact Kelly Summers at 630.554.4064.

Epact is our online emergency network where you can securely add, manage, and share your child's key health and emergency contact information with us. Please make sure you have completed this and uploaded the necessary documents before the first day of school.
