## SAW WEE KEE PARK TRAILS

## - TRAIL USAGE RULES -

Ride on open trails only - Respect trail closures and emergency access roads.

**Leave no trace** - Clean your bike wheels and shoes before leaving the park. Wet and muddy trails are more vulnerable to damage. Dispose of trash in proper receptacles.

Control your bicycle - Stay on existing trails and don't create new ones.

Yield to others - Respect trail users and share the trail.

**Never scare animals** - Animals are easily startled by an unannounced approach, sudden movement, or loud noise.

**Plan ahead** - Be aware of your surroundings. Make use of park maps to identify your location in the case of an emergency or if you are lost.

## CONDITIONS OF USE -

Use these trails at your own risk and with caution. These trails are also used for maintenance duties.

Trails are open sunrise to sunset.

Helmets are required for all bicycle riders. Other safety gear is encouraged.

Penalties will apply to infractions of any posted Trail Usage Rules or Conditions of Use. Park Code Ordinances may be viewed at oswegolandparkdistrict.org.
